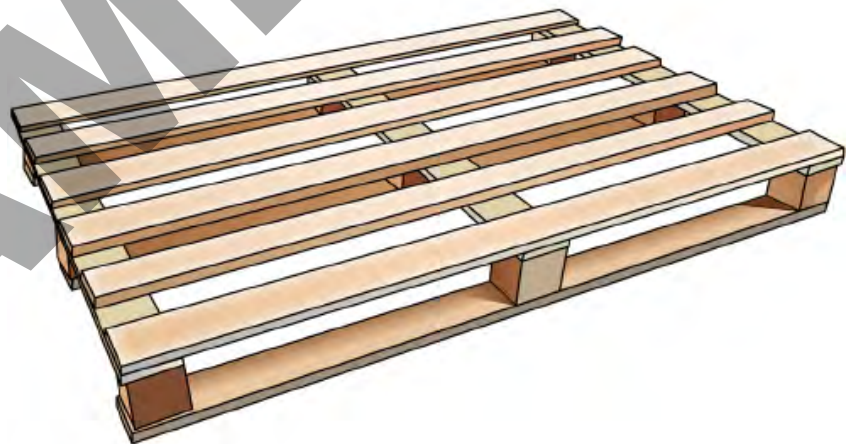
3. Carrying a load with a forklift
